# **Approve Previous Meeting Minutes**

# Treasurer's Report

\$1540 donated through the Boeing match.

\$996 dollar grade level grant made to the 1st grade.

\$51,240 is the balance of our main bank account.

There are several potential expenses that may be realized in June totaling approximately \$10K. We project a surplus of \$15K over our starting point this year.

There will be a "last call" for grants from Teachers. Teachers were initially notified in February.

Dr. H – Each class could use more books, headphones, classroom supplies, new folding tables.

The General membership meeting can be used to reallocate some of the excess budget for school supplies (tables, coin counters, restorative justice).

# President's Update

First nomination email sent for Golden Acorn and Outstanding Educator. Very little response for outstanding educator. Both award winners are invited to Founder's Day on May 19<sup>th</sup>.

The Golden Acorn was won by Skyer Burreson and will be awarded during the last assembly of the year.

Student Showcase (2JUN23) – ASB and the PTSA are teaming up. ASB has filled all the roles needed. It will consist of a talent show, Choir Performance, & art walk. Runtime TBD and dependent on # of kids participating.

General Membership meeting is being moved from the Thursday the 25<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup> to move it away from Memorial Day Weekend. This must be communicated quickly.

# Principle's Report

Festival of Cultures is next week (not a PTSA event). The flow is still being worked out.
